Be it remembered that on this the seventh day of May in the year of our Lord 1839 This indenture bargain purchase and release into between James Johnston Senr ^{man, defendant} of the Fleming county of the one part & ^{of the} other part ~~Antony~~ that the sd Johnston being in a weak & feeble State of Body unable to take care of himself doth hereby agree to & with sd defendant to take care of provide for and maintain him in a human manner & furnish him with all the necessaries of life such as must elicit lodging wearing apparel nursing & attention as far as appears enable & right to the sd defendant doth hereby covenant & agree to do & perform all these sd duties & attention to & for the sd Johnston or procure it done for him & for & carry his natural life & the sd defendant to have a reasonable compensation for his troubles, ^{& maintenance} ~~costs~~ his money which is coming to me the sd Johnston from millers & messengers for the land & premises which he purchased of sd Johnston the notes for which is deposited in the hands of John Debel the notes into the w for the notes being four in number to be paid annually the amt they call for is about \$60

The first come due the 10th day of March next.

This compensation to sd defendant is to be paid States & determined as to the amt by the arbitrators now chosen by the sd defendant on his part and by the other party to be chosen by John Debel a agent for the sd John Johnston & if they can agree they are to call in and require the first annual instalment of the compensation to be paid in one year or twelve months from this date & it is my will & wish that if there should be any overplus after my decease & paying all demands debts against me sd Johnston that I do hereby give & bequeath the whole all & every species of property claim & interest & every description I may have or have or be entitled to in any way unto the sd John Debel his heirs & assigns in compensation to him for past services to me and my family the testimony whereof the parties have hereunto subscribed their names the day and date first written Improving

I John Debel do hereby acknowledge that I have the notes referred to in the foregoing which I obligate my self to demand for when called on as they may become due or I can collect them but not to be accountable if I can not collect them or any part thereof Witness my hand this 7th day of May 1839.

Also two notes on James Johnston for twenty five dollars each due to same on the 31st December 1839 the first

The other due 31st December 1838 I am to account for as above at account held for Fleming county on the 1st Nov 1839. This writing preparing to be the last will and testament

Of James Johnston was procured in court previously the oath of Human day & David Hopkins and names & names which is now Attest John Johnston clerk

ory bless'd be the all mighty God for the same & consid-
ering the uncertainty of this mortal life do make publick
and declare this to be my last will & Testament writing

following {VIZ} That after all my Just debts shall
be paid I give and bequeath to my Belov'd wife
Elizabeth Patton one third of all my real and personal
estate & mines including the mansion house together
with Kitchen Stables out houses &c.

 I bequeath of my land in the State of Missouri Sect

 quarter also my Black Boy Joe also an equal part
 with the rest of my children of money arising from
 the sale of the surplus property money on hand
 & counting what he has received as part of his share
 also the money & share of my father's Legacy paid to
 him is to be considered as a part of his share also one
 feather bed bedshead and bedding 3rd To my second
 son Michell I bequeath of my land in the State of Missouri
 the South east quarter of Section 18 Township 64 Range
 3 west also one ^{an} equal part with the rest of my children
 of the money on hand and money arising from sale
 of the surplus property also one black girl named Louisa
 also one feather bed bedshead and bedding.
 4th To my third Son James I bequeath of my land
 in the State of Missouri the south west quarter of
 Section 1 Township 54 Range 4 W. also 2 Blk
 Boys children named Isaac & Scipio also an
 equal part with the rest of my children of the
 money on hand & money arising from the
 sale of the surplus property also one brother Ben Bonastear & Reading
 5th To my three daughters I bequeath as follows to wit:
