In the name of God amen I John Hockason of Stanning County and State of Kentucky being in the evening of Life and frail in Body and feeble in mind and, manly and thanks be to god for his mercies to me, and calling to mind that man was born to die I therefore make and declare this to be my last will and testament first I commit my body to the earth to be buried in a decent manner in the Christian form and my soul to god that gave it and as respects my worldly goods they are to be disposed of in the following manner after my decease first I give and bequeath to my son William Hockason my land and premises and the appurtenances and also all my personal Estate that I shall then possess with an exception hereafter made I give my Beloved wife first ^{the sum of} \$1000 of my personal Estate to be paid to her by 18 months out of my personal Estate or one third Part of ^{the same} my Estate to each of them to be at his option which to give as it might happen that the personal estate might not justify him

to give them forty dollars each and take one
third part himself. Besides the land which is hereby in-
cluded for him to hold all our Decedent and the
two daughters one third each of the ~~same~~ Personal
Estate should not amount to more than forty dollars
each. It is to be further observed and understood

In this presents my last will and testament that for the
consideration therein ^{mentioned} bequeathed to him he has promised
and doth agree to keep and support in a decent
manner myself and my beloved wife Betsey along
as it may please God for as long as I should live
him my son William to be the longest. Ever he is to keep
us free from want and in a decent and comfortable
manner so long as we or either of us may live
and let it now and hereafter be understood
that my son William is to enable to comply with his
promised and agreement to us his father & mother
as respects our maintenance I do deliver to his
care and custody from the date of this presents
the said land and personal property of his own and
proper use after my just debts are paid to be held and
to his use so long as the said William

Performs
his contract and agreement in supporting us
his mother and father and Mother John &
Elizabeth Beckhams according to his agreement given
under my hand and seal this 15th day of Oct
