In the name of God amen I Charles Reaves of the County of Fleming and Commonwealth of Kentucky considering the uncertainty of this mortal life and being of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be allmighty God for the same do make and publish this my last will and last intent in manner and form following (Wiz) just after paying my just debts and paying the expenses of my burial I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Sarah Reaves during her natural life all the land on which I now reside except what parts thereof as she may otherwise dispose of with all the improvements thereon all the household & Kitchen furniture all the live stock & all whatever else here may be growing or otherwise that I may die possessed of but provided she should not be inclined to retain all the personal estate to her during above bequeathed until her decease she may at any time surrender any part thereof that she may think proper to my executor hereafter named to be by him (or stock) applied towards paying James Thomas and brother the amount to them hereafter bequeathed here of household stuff to be applied towards paying for not doing what to her is hereafter bequeathed I do give and bequeath unto my son John Reaves 2 1/2 acres of land to be laid off to him on the east end of the farm aforesaid and within six months after my decease and to be laid off so as to be of equal breadth at the north and south ends. I do also give and bequeath unto my son Charles Reaves Eighty two and one half acres of land to be laid off to him on the west end of the first aforesaid land within six months after my decease as follows (Wiz) beginning at the north west corner of the 28 first aforesaid which is a deed of conveyance from Lewis Craig to me for 28
