I from 2nd I give to Samuel Harrison such of my clothing as he may think proper to receive

I from 3rd It is my will and desire that the interest there in the three following named Slaves (to wit) Middy Jane and Frank should go to the said Shuck so far as my part of their hire each are receiving my part of their hire yearly

I from 4th I give and bequeath to my Sons Obedience O Brown and Scurainer Brown all the residue of my Estate both real & personal after paying the above named legacies

5th and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my Brother Rachel R Brown Executor of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all other or former wills or testaments heretofore made by me and it is my will and desire that my said executor shall not be required to give any security for his administration of my estate

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 9th day of August Eighteen hundred and thirty three
