Third All the rest of my property whether personal or real (after the foregoing bequests are separated) I wish to be equally and fairly divided distributed among the following persons to wit John Brain James Brain Joseph Brain Lewis Brain Mary Brain Amundale Brain Elizabeth Little Nancy Johnson & Johnnie Johnson
It is my wish that my sons Lewis and William be administrators and executors of this my last will and testament which is made with a perfect understanding and in the fear of God my judges and after much deliberation as witnessed my hand and seal
