I Della Allen of Floyd County Kentucky being of sound mind and disposing memory do make and publish the following as my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills made by me.

I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid out of my estate

I give bequeath and devise to my beloved wife Mary Bradley and to my nine children to-wit: Lura Bradley, Lucy Leason wife of Walter Leason, Maudie Stone wife of Blaine Stone, Katie Warner wife of John Warner Jr, George Bradley, John Bradley, Marie Bradley and Elmer Bradley, and Lora Bradley all the real estate

which I now own or may hereafter acquire and of which I may die seized whether in possession reversion or remainder jointly, that is to say share and share alike which real estate at this time consists of my farm of about five hundred and fifty acres situated on Right Branch Creek in Floyd County Kentucky and being the same upon which I now live and reside and being the same land conveyed to me by my Grand Parents Isaac Stone & Elizabeth Stone by deed dated August 1862 and not however is to a life estate of my parents. Isaac Bradley and Jane Bradley as provided for in said

deed. It is my will that my said wife shall have the exclusive use of the mansion or dwelling house in which I now live together with the smoke house stable barn and all out buildings and the entire all the live stock I now own and all the household and kitchen furniture of every kind and character and by whatever name known to be used by her in such manner as she may deem best in the rearing of all my infant children such use and occupancy by her as aforesaid to continue until my youngest child attains the age of twenty-one years, or marry the use of same be by my said wife for the benefit of herself and said infant children to be true and for which no suit shall ever be charged. This last request in behalf of my said wife and infant children shall in no way affect the right of my said wife and each infant child to an equal one fourth interest in my real estate aforesaid and as hereinafter provided.

I have here made nominate and appointed my son Truman Bradley to be the executor of this my last will and testament and I request that no bond be required of him in such. I further request that no inventory of my estate be made or taken in so far as the same may be lawfully admitted.
