

I Acktho Stone is of the County of Floyd and State of
 Kentucky being of sufficient health but somewhat infirm and desirous to
 settle and arrange all my worldly affairs do hereby declare of my
 property in the manner and form following to-wit: The same in
 which I am spending my son or last son lives being on the left
 hand side of Horse Creek in Floyd County being the same I purchased
 of William Stone and decided to sell by John Stone the title being
 on him when I purchased of William Stone also fifteen acres which
 was decided to one of Abner Spauldin recorded in Book A Page 17-18
 in the Floyd County Court House office the deed from Peter Stone
 recorded in Book A Page 513 in the same office which said I do
 hereby give and bequeath to the children of Abner Spauldin or any he
 may have by his wife Sally Spauldin formerly Sally Stone.
 All the land contained in said deeds from the lower end of the
 survey joining Abner Spauldin and running up the left hand corner
 including the old survey and the new survey up to where said John
 Spauldin now found fence comes to the river on the north side of
 said creek then on the left hand side of the creek going up from said
 fence all the land contained in the old survey which I do hereby give
 to said children for the consideration of the natural love and affection
 I have for them they being my lawful children and as my design
 is that said land should be appropriate for the purpose of raising
 & support for said children and the sustenance of land being small
 I desire it on each summer his share of them shall have any
 lease or considerable rights to said land until the youngest one
 attains the age of twenty one years and then the land to belong
 to them jointly and wife Spauldin as long as he lives on it is to
 have as much but to have the use of it to enable him to raise
 the children but by he swore off of it were to abandon it
 then the same is to be rented by my executor & the proceeds applied
 to the support of said children and if Spauldin dies the Mother
 of the children to put said land as above conditioned to Spauldin
 and the land lying above the aforementioned fence which Peter
 Stone now lives lying on the right hand side of Horse Creek
 I want to him at his right disposal to do with as he think
 proper to one wife Sally I want all the tools and furniture going
 now with me except which she has always claimed also my notes & the
 note taking care of her to receive them as compensation for their
 trouble
 I also want to Peter Stone a white cow & myself of George
 of wife Sally Spauldin also a field growing wheat to the
 same & give the Fido black white cow I bought of
 Randall Spauldin to Mingoah Spauldin also 1000 acres
 of land situated to the Stone which I bought of John Stone

lying on the top of the divide between Siskiwit & French 14
to send Michigan Spauldin in consideration for his attention to Michigan
also to come in and lying on the left and look after Siskiwit
where it stands from Lake Huron or near

The land on which I now live on which and being the same & purchased of Samuel May & son by my own Enoch Stone on the following conditions to wit: that he have all my debts in their entirety from my decessor Samy Municipality to S^r Nathan use of Bristowbury and my True Debt & my father say he is to have possession of the land at the abolition of said their mortgage of the said debt with the said conditions subject to S^r Stone lease part of the said to comply then my ancestor to said said land make a true & full purchase within the space towards the payment of said debt and the possession to be in him until they shall be paid or released and my children of said said to be taken to Enoch Stone & also give to Enoch Stone my wife Ann and afterwards Henry May & son

I am in to effect all that is necessary in the foregoing will & be thereby substituted as the said Samuel W. Jones the executor of the
my last will and testament to act for me as my agent & carry
said will into effect also in my name. I agree to the above &
assign the title to a piece of land on which above Hooker & I
own which I gave a title bond to said Brown for redemption
to Hooker & when the inclosed money is paid - my executor
des to receive the debt that may become due from said
Brown for the land I leased to him & appoint the proceeds to
the use & benefit of my wife.

I Charles Stone of the County of Floyd and State of Ky being of sound mind and memory I make publish and declare this to be my last will and testament to wit: all my just debts and funeral expenses shall be fully paid out of my personal property.

2nd I will my last wife Margaret Stone one dollar and bring her whole interest in my real estate and personal property.

3rd I will my daughter Rebecca Stockworth a piece of land at the upper end of my farm on the left hand side of the creek beginning as follows - beginning on a rock on the field near the mouth of a basin at the foot of the hill thence with the stream straight line to the top of the hill thence with my back line down the point to the creek thence with the creek down opposite of the beginning thence a straight line to the beginning.

4th I will to my daughter Sarah Benton a piece of land on the same side of the creek at the lower end beginning as follows: Beginning at the creek on George Stones line thence with a stone line to the water line thence with the said water line to the creek thence with the creek to the beginning.

5th I will to my son and daughter the balance of my estate my son George Stone is to make the division line between him and his sisters and Sallie Grace is to have choice of the divide in witness where I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the 28th day of July 1894.
