

Will of C. G. Hager

Know all men by these presents that I, C. G. Hager of East Point, Kentucky, being of sound mind and memory do this day make and declare this to be my last will and testament.

First all my just debts and funeral expenses be fully paid.

Second, I bequeath or give unto my wife Josie Hager Control of the farm and house hold affairs as long as she remains my widow.

Third: I give unto Malcom Hager my son one seventh of my estate.

4th I give unto Chaney Hager one seventh of my estate.

Fifth I give unto my daughter Rebecca Baldridge one seventh of my estate.

Sixth I give unto my daughter Oma Badgett one seventh of my estate.

Seventh I give unto my son John Hager one seventh of my estate.

Eight, I give unto my son Harry Hager one seventh of my estate.

Ninth I give unto my son Charley Hager one seventh of my estate.

I nominate and appoint my son Chaney Hager the executor of this my last will and testament.

Hager, and admitted to record, and the Clerk of this Court will record the same upon the Will Book of his Court, together with a copy of this order. He will enter this order upon the order book of his Court as a part of this day's orders.
