Clark, my brother, to act as executor under this my Last Will and Testament, to serve without bond or surety, and with full power to sell, mortgage, ple., exchange, lease or in any other manner whatsoever to handle or dispose of all or any part of my estate without first procuring an order of court or giving notice thereof.

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT
OF
CYNTHIA HOLBROOK

I, Cynthia Holbrook, of Middle Creek Floyd County, Kentucky being of sound mind and memory do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my last Will and Testament.

FIRST: I do hereby direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be paid out of my estate.

SECOND: I do hereby give, bequeath and devise all the remainder of my personal property of every sort, nature and kind, to Holsey Holbrook, Henry E. Holbrook, Walter Holbrook, Jonathan P. Holbrook, Grover C. Holbrook, Minerva E. Sprellin, and Jonathan P. Holbrook as Trustees for Edmund Andre Holbrook, share and share alike.

THIRD: I do hereby give, devise and bequeath all the coal, oil, gas, minerals and subterranean products of every sort or nature, in, upon and under any and all lands which I may own at the time of my death, together with any and all other coal, oil, gas, mineral and subterranean products which I may own at the time of my death, to Holsey Holbrook, Henry E. Holbrook, Walter Holbrook, Jonathan P. Holbrook, Grover C. Holbrook, Minerva E. Sprellin, and Jonathan P. Holbrook as Trustees for Edmund Andre Holbrook, share and share alike.

FOURTH: ALL the remainder of my property which I may own at the time of my death I desire to bequeath and to be distributed according to the provisions of the Statute of Descent and Distribution of the State of Kentucky.

FIFTH: The one-seventy of my personal property and of my coal, oil, gas, minerals and subterranean products hereinbefore devised to Jonathan P. Holbrook as Trustee for Edmund Andre Holbrook shall be held by the said Jonathan P. Holbrook, Trustee, and/or his successor as such Trustee, for the use and benefit of the said Edmund Andre Holbrook, upon the following terms, conditions and trusts, to-wit:

(a) Said Trustee shall have, hold, manage and control said properties hereinbefore devised to him until such time as the said Edmund Andre Holbrook shall arrive at the age of twenty one years, or until such trust is terminated according to the further provisions hereof.

(b) Said Trustee is hereby given power and authority to lease and/or release from time to time and may/or devide to him; to enter into agreements or agreements extending any existing leases or leases upon said properties or any portion of the same; all upon such terms and conditions as to him may seem proper; to collect from time to time any and all rentals or royalties which may accrue upon or from any existing or future leases upon said properties.

(c) Said Trustee is hereby given power and authority to invest and/or reinvest the principal of the personal properties hereinbefore bequeathed to him, and any and all income arising from the properties hereinbefore devised or bequeathed to him; to buy, own and hold and sell said properties for said Trust Estate as in his judgment may be proper; which may be legal investments under the laws of the State of Kentucky.

(d) All income arising from said Trust Estate shall be collected by such Trustee. Said Trustee is hereby authorized from time to time to pay any portion of said income to the Guardian of the said Edmund Andre Holbrook, for the use and benefit of the said Edmund Andre Holbrook, as in the judgment of said Trustee may be just and proper; provided, however, that the said Trustee shall exercise his judgment and discretion as to whether or not he shall make any such payment or payments and the judgment and discretion of the said Trustee relative thereto shall be final and conclusive, and shall not be controlled by any person or persons or by any court.

(e) In the event of any illness of the said Edmund Andre Holbrook, the Trustee, aforesaid, is authorized and empowered BUT NOT DIRECTED, to use such portion or portions of the said trust estate, including income or principal, as in his judgment or discretion may be necessary or advantageous to be expended for said Edmund Andre Holbrook on account of such illness.

(f) Said trustee aforesaid, is authorized and empowered, BUT NOT DIRECTED to use such portion or portions of said trust estate, including principal or income, or both, as in his judgment or discretion may be necessary or advantageous to be expended for the education of the said Edmund Andre Holbrook.

(g) When the said Edmund Andre Holbrook shall arrive at the age of twenty-one years, then the said Trustee hereinbefore aforesaid, or his successor in office, shall convey to the said Edmund Andre Holbrook the oil, gas, coal, oil, gas, minerals and subterranean products hereinbefore devised and bequeathed to such Trustee, and small amount for pay over and deliver to the said Edmund Andre Holbrook all monies coming into his hands on such Trustee aforesaid, less any expenditures paid therefor. PROVIDED, however, that should the said Edmund Andre Holbrook depart this life prior to the time he arrives at the age of twenty one years, then the trust estate hereinbefore provided for him shall cease and terminate and terminate, and in that event the said Trustee aforesaid, or his successor in office, shall convey the land title to said coal, oil, gas, minerals and subterranean products to the said Holsey Holbrook, Henry E. Holbrook, Walter Holbrook, Jonathan P. Holbrook, Grover C. Holbrook and Minerva E. Sprellin, share and share alike.
