

SECOND: Whereas, Katie Crisp of Dwaile, Kentucky has waited upon and taken care of me since September, 1951, and my children and relatives have failed or refused to take care of me or support or provide for me in any way since long before September, 1951, I will, bequeath and devise to Katie Crisp all of my property, including lands, money, personal property and all notes and choses I leave at the time of my death, after the payment of my just debts and funeral expenses as aforesaid.
