

Invoking the blessing of God upon myself and family I Elliott Stone being of sound mind and disposing memory do hereby make this my last will and testament.

I direct that all of my debts including my funeral expenses be paid by Mary Stone my wife. I here by bequeath all my real estate on the Bee Farm known as my home farm to my beloved wife Mary and my three children - Elbert, Malcolm and Mattie the three children sharing equally. I desire that all my personal property including farming implements and real estate at Bonanza Stone house and lot, one dwelling and seven acres of land and my interest in the Hart Smith house and lot joining B. F. Baldrige and James Greer be owned and controlled by my wife Mary.

I desire further that my wife Mary shall collect all my accounts, notes and debts including my accounts against Prof. Byington of about four hundred and forty dollars (\$440.00). I direct that as soon as possible after my decease, my wife Mary shall settle my business with the County Court as guardian of the Harrie Stanley heirs and receive my release from bond of Administrators, Thomas Stanley. I desire further that when Andy Shonts is released from bond for his appearance now held against him by the Grant Court of Johnson County Ky. that the bond brought from Canada Shonts by Andy Shonts paid back to Andy Shonts and that the part owed by Melissa Shonts from her father Wm. G. Shonts paid back to her individually. Having the utmost confidence in the integrity of my wife Mary I leave I hereby appoint her my executrix without bond to carry out the provisions of this my will.
