do make publish and declare this to be my last will and
testament to wit:

First of all my just debts and funeral expenses
shall first be duly paid

2. I do will and bequeath to my beloved daughter
Lella Hendricks one house and lot known as the Isaac
Hoble property lot Beginning on the line of the C & O R R Co
thence running down the County road about 66
feet to a fence thence a straight to the line of Julia
Moorey thence with said line to the line of C & O R R Co
thence down with said line to the place of beginning
containing about 8 acres to have and to hold same together to
her and her heirs forever

Second I do will and bequeath to my beloved son Della
Hendricks the house and lot where I know live being all the lot
I purchased of Mrs. Noble Charles son

3 I do will and bequeath to my beloved brother
Malcolm Hendricks ten dollars (\$10) to be paid in cash

4 I do will and bequeath all the balance of my estate both
real and personal to my beloved wife Dicy Hendricks so long
as she lives or stays single then said property is to be
equally divided among my children

5th. The property I will to Della and Della Hendricks
my beloved wife Dicy Hendricks is to have the full
control over it so long as she lives or stays single
in plain words she is to have full control over
everything I have left as my desire is to have her and
for first as we have had the struggle of life together
which has been very burdensome
