

*Last Will and Testament of J. C. Bailey
of Allen City Ky.*

I J. C. Bailey of the County of Floyd and
the State of Kentucky and now at Allen, City therein
being of free age and sound mind and memory,
do make, publish and declare, this to be my last
Will and Testament, hereby revoking all wills by me
hitherto made,

Item I I direct that all my just debts be paid
out of my estate. Also my funeral expenses as soon
as practicable after the time of my decease.

Item II I bequeath to my son Brut Bailey the
sum of \$50.00 to be his full share of my estate

I bequeath to my daughter Pearl Bailey
Lewis the sum of \$50.00 to be her full share in
my estate. <sup>I bequeath to my son John Bailey the sum of \$50.00 to be
his full share of my estate</sup>

I bequeath to my daughter Cora Bailey
Cooper, the sum of \$50.00 to be her full share
in my estate.

Then the remainder of my estate whatever
it may be personal or realty or both shall go to
my wife Mary Bailey and my daughter Alta Bailey
share and share alike or equally between them.

But if my wife Mary should die before
my daughter Alta Bailey then Alta shall have
her part, but if Alta dies before my wife Mary
Bailey then my wife Mary Bailey shall have
Alta's part of my estate. But if they both die
before I do, that is my wife Mary Bailey and
Alta Bailey, then my whole estate shall go to my
first four children, Brut Bailey, Pearl Bailey,
Lewie, Cora Cooper and John Bailey.

Item III I make nominate and appoint my
wife Mary Bailey, to be the executor of this my
last will and testament, and I request that no
bond be required of her as such.

I further request that no inventory of my estate
be made or taken in so far as the same be
lawfully omitted.
