LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF DR. CHARLES F. BOND.

I, Dr. Charles F. Bond, of 2233 Winchester Ave., Ashland, Boyd County, Kentucky, being of sound and disposing mind, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my last will and testament; hereby revoking all former wills by me made.

ITEM 1. It is my will and wish that first of all after my decease that all my just debts be paid out of my estate, including especially those of my last illness and burial expenses.

ITEM 2. It is my will and wish that all my Building and Loan stock, of whatsoever kind owned by me at my death, be divided equally between my children, or if any of them is deceased, then his or her share to go to his or her surviving children. It is my further will and wish that said stock so divided be left intact and all interests and dividends realized thereon shall be used to purchase additional stock of the same kind until said stock so purchased equals the amount originally divided and the said children are to have no control over same until it has so divided, when it is to be delivered to them to be used as their best judgment directs.

ITEM 3. All the rest and residue of my estate, both real and personal, I devise, and bequeath to my beloved wife, Cordelia M. Bond, to have and to hold and to be her own so long as she remains my widow, and in case of her re-marriage, then it shall be placed, in its entirety, in the hands of a responsible Trust Company to be divided equally between my children, or if any are deceased, then his or her share to go to his or her children; said Trust Company to deliver each child his or her share when he or she reaches the age of, or has passed the age of 25 years and not before such age has been attained.

ITEM 4. It is my will and wish that Cordelia M. Bond be appointed Executrix of this, my last will and testament and that she be permitted to serve without executing bond or filing inventory, and that she as such shall have full power to transfer to other Building and Loan Associations any or all of the stock mentioned in Item 2 in case, in her judgment, the Corporation becomes unsound or fails to give their several interests due and proper consideration.

ITEM 5. The above property is the fruit of my tireless labor and this will conveys to my heirs how I desire it to be handled, and if any, or either of them should attempt to thwart or destroy my desires as expressed in this will, I respectfully ask the Hon.
