

I John Hamilton Jr of Harrods Hays Co Ky do make this my last Will and Testament being of sound mind and memory do make this my last Will and Testament my First & hereby appoint my Brother Joel Hamilton as my Chief Executor and Ernest Hamilton Jr as assistant Executor as soon after my death as possible to collect and pay off all my indebtedness and to settle up all my business in every respect

Second I bequeath unto my wife Margaret R. my my home place at mouth of Sanny Creek branch the part I first bought of little James Clark containing about 30 acres her entire life time then to fall to my Brother Joel Hamilton. I also bequeath unto my wife \$20000 \$10000 to be paid out of my life insurance and \$10000 to be paid out of mineral stock when sold & disposed of - also unto my wife 1 one Bar Horse 2 cows all the Hays & fowls & household & kitchen furniture except 3 beds and outfit which I want given to my Brother William & 3 youngest children

Third I bequeath unto my Brother Joel Hamilton all the remainder of my Estate both real & Personal including all lands wherever located mineral lands and also all Coal and mineral stock, all personal property and accounts also all life Insurance policies and standing timber and all other stuff that I may own at my decease Providing now the said Joel Hamilton and E Hamilton Jr to sell dispose of & collect the following and pay to the said parties below mentioned the sums below mentioned John Hamilton Sr (my Father) a sum not to exceed \$3000 year to go to his individual benefit for taken care of him in his old days

To the heirs of my Brother Lewis Hamilton deceased the sum of \$10000 equally divided to the heirs of Bro William Hamilton deceased the sum of \$8000 to be equally divided divided to the heirs of John William Hamilton \$4000 equally divided To the youngest daughter of my Brother William Hamilton Hays the sum of \$2000 also to the youngest Son my Hamilton \$2000 also the \$20000 as above mentioned to my wife Margaret R Hamilton

Fourth I want my executor as soon after my death and burial as possible to collect and pay off all my debts and make settlements smoothly as possible collect Insurance sell mineral lands & mineral stock and personal property & lands enough to pay off all the above mentioned sums as early as can conveniently be done and pay each and all in

proportion as collected and when all the above mentioned sums and settlements are made then the said Joel Hamilton Executor shall pay to the said Ernest Hamilton assistant Executor the sum of \$10000 for his services for helping settle up my estate Fifth I want the remainder of all my estate to belong to my Brother Joel Hamilton after all settlements are made
