Know men by these presents that Artie Elliott being in bad health but sound in mind and aware that my last will and testament as follows

That all my real estate to wit: two farm lots near Hanns Ky be sold and the money obtained from their sale be equally divided between my four children to wit: Samuel, et al, this will and that all my personal & property of whatsoever kind I may own at my death be equally divided among my heirs. Therefore it is my will that after the sale of said property as my just debts be first paid and of the payment of my debts if there be any, then the remainder be equally divided between: Henry Harmon at Anderson Ky, Thomas Harmon at Aust, Randolph Ky, Willie Elliott at Prestonburg Ky, Lucy Robinson at Back Ky and Robert St. Elliott at Back Ky and that the last named is hereby appointed by me as trustee as administrator without bond to sell convey pay off my debts and divide the remainder as set out in this will

Endreacht William Endreacht my boys is to have all the land I own on the right hand side of Buffalo as you go down the creek commencing from the second line running down Buffalo as it now runs each side is not to turn the creek on each side and I to control all I own on this side as long as I live William Endreacht is not to receive of this land after my death and he is to sell to my child James and not to sell to no one without he is in bad necessity

This is to certify that I intend for John, the James to have all the land I own above the house from the line made by J. H. Endreacht & C. E. Goble this land has a Buffalo on the right hand side of Buffalo as you go up the creek and J. H. Endreacht is going to control this as long as he lives and in the way I want her, have farm but Pearl is to have my support as long as she remains my widow
