 I bequeath to my daughter Rhoda Hamilton Five hundred and twenty dollars in cash in addition to the five hundred dollars heretofore advanced to her, I bequeath my daughter Elizabeth Hamilton Five hundred and twenty dollars in cash in addition to the five hundred dollars heretofore advanced to her, I bequeath to my daughter Polly Allen Five hundred and twenty dollars in cash in addition to Five hundred dollars heretofore advanced to her, I bequeath to my daughter Non Hamilton Five hundred and twenty dollars in cash in addition to the Five hundred dollars heretofore advanced to her I bequeath to my Grand children Art Dockitt Margaret Hall Judy Dockitt Eddie Martin Maudey Martin Johnny Martin & I own another heir of my daughter Corine Martin die One hundred forty five dollars twenty one & seven tenths cents \$145.71 7/10 each or one thousand and twenty dollars in cash to be Equally divided between them or they are my daughters might have had any advancement of my estate. I bequeath to my Grand children Francis Prasure and Seyrus Prasure heirs of my son John Prasure Four hundred & fifty dollars (\$450) each in cash or nine hundred dollars in cash to be equally divided between them or they or my son John die might have had any advancement I bequeath to my Grand children William Newson one hundred dollars in cash in addition to two hundred dollars heretofore given him and to Bertha Newson one hundred dollars in cash in addition to two hundred dollars heretofore advanced to him and Robert Newson three hundred dollars in cash he having no advancement or nine hundred dollars in all they the said William Newson Bertha Newson and Robert Newson being the only heirs of

my daughter Francis Newson I bequeath to my sons Robert Prasure and Sam Prasure one dollar each as they have had more advancement than any of the rest of my heirs. I also desire and direct that after my death all my lands money personal property goods or chattels of whatsoever kind after my burial expenses and just debt if any be paid to be equally divided among my heirs according to the laws of distribution or descent.
