

Last Will and Testament of H. F. Hite Dec'd

I, H. F. Hite of the City of Huntington Cabell County West Virginia declare this to be my last will and Testament

I give, devise and bequeath all my property, real, Personal and mixed to my wife Anna C Hite with the following provisions:

1. That my said wife shall furnish to my son Ely Hite, and to my daughter, Mrs. Warner E. Jones from time to time, any and all money which in her discretion she shall deem necessary and proper.

2. In case my said wife should decide to remarry, then and in that event my estate is to be divided equally among herself, my son Ely Hite, and my daughter Mrs. Warner E. Jones share and share alike: said division and transfer to be made not less than sixty (60) days prior to the performance of such marriage ceremony.

3. No credit shall be taken for any money that may be furnished from time to time to my said daughter and son as provided in paragraph "1", in any division of my said estate as provided in paragraph "2".

4. The provision herein made for my said wife shall be in lieu of all rights of dower or statutory right to participate in this division of my estate.

It is my intention and my desire that my said son and daughter, both of whom are infants, be amply provided for, and in making the provisions herein, it is done with the feeling that I have the best assurance to this end through a mother's natural love and affection for her children.

I hereby nominate and appoint the Huntington National Bank (Mrs. C. M. Fisher President) and the said Anna C. Hite to be executor and executrix of this my will to serve without bond and without inventory.

I, W. F. Hite of the City of Huntington, Cabell County, West Virginia declare this to be my last will and testament.

I give devise and bequeath all my property, real personal and mixed to my wife Anna C. Hite with the following provisions:

1. That my said wife shall furnish to my son Ely Hite and to my daughter Mrs. Warner E. Jones from time to time any and all money which in her discretion she shall deem necessary and proper.

2. In case my said wife decide to remarry again then and at that event, my estate is to be divided equally among herself, my son Ely Hite and my daughter Mrs. Warner E. Jones, share and share alike said division and transfer to be made not less than 60 days prior to the performance of such marriage ceremony.

3. No Credit shall be taken for any moneys that may be furnished from time to time to my said son and daughter, as provided in Paragraph 1, in any division of my said estate as provided in Paragraph 2.
