living in my right mind and knowing that I cannot live longer than
in health and who has no other heirs or next of kin in peace do hereby
bequeath the same I bequeath my real estate in the following manner to wit
to Martha Allen & Mary Allen I will and bequeath of my real estate to them
and to Mary Allen the other half Martha Allen and Mary Allen is to
pay Martha Cook twenty five dollars cash at the expiration of ten
years which will be in 1898 and to Frank Danner, Martha Allen
& Mary Allen is to pay twenty five dollars to be paid also in 1898
and to John Danner, Martha Allen & Mary Allen is to pay to him
fifty dollars to be paid also in 1898 and to my daughter Sarah Allen
Martha Allen & Mary Allen is to pay to her twenty five dollars to be
paid at the expiration of ten years which will be in 1898.
