 Jally Gibbon one Negro (Book) until Mr Gibbon gets of age.
 Then the said William Gibbon is to have him during his life
 and his lawful heirs begettin of him forever, But if he should
 die without issue the said Negro Book is to be equally divided
 amongst my Daughter Jally Gibbons surviving children.
 I likewise give Mr Gibbon my horses, my cattle and my sheep
 5th I give all the rest of my Estate to my Daughter
 Jally Gibbon. And her heirs, except a Negro woman named Moll
 which at my Death shall be at perfect liberty, and is my
 request that my Executors and Executors, which I hereby
 appoint name Edmund Vaughans, John Brown, & Ernest
 Dr. Martine, might see that it was seen and lawfully done
 so to observe the contents of my last Will and Testament: In
 Witness whereof I have set my hand and affixed my
 seal this 15th day of February 1796.

 Brother John Robinson for Alexander Robinson to be
 and her heirs forever - Revoking and Disannulling
 all other Wills by me heretofore made. I appoint
 and have chosen John Robinson and I Daniel
 to be my Executors In Witness whereof I have
 unto set my hand and seal this 21th Sept 1796
