It is also my desire that it be perfectly understood that I have sold for a valuable consideration my negroes Lucy, Mark and Stephen and increased to William Robinson. In witness whereof I have again subscribed this declaration to my last will and Testament.

But before signing the latter to confirm the said William Robinson's debts said negroes do hereby give & bequeath the said negroes Lucy, Mark & Stephen to said Robinson his heirs and assigns forever. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 10th day of October 1836.

1st Item it is my will and desire that all my estate be disposed by my executors hereafter mentioned and my body decedently raised to my worldly property & that I have desired God to bestow on me I leave as follows One dollar and all other property that I have heretofore given her.

2nd Item I leave and bequeath to my daughter Nancy Robinson one dollar and all other property that I have heretofore given her. I also leave and bequeath to my daughter Patsy Braden one dollar and all other property that I have heretofore given her.

3rd Item I leave and bequeath to my son George Ford one dollar and all other property I have heretofore given him I leave and bequeath to my daughter Polly Harton one dollar and all other property I have heretofore given her.

4th Item I leave and bequeath to my daughter Polly Lewis one dollar and all other property that I have heretofore given her.

Shew, I have and bequeath to my beloved wife Nancy
 First my house of land with several acres containing six hundred
 and twenty three acres be the same man or off and all my stock
 of horses, cattle, sheep, and hogs, all within house hold and
 the other furniture of my dwelling house also all the provisions
 now and all the plantation lots of every description
 and all the money that may be due in at my death by bond or
 Open account, also all the gear, turkeys, & such specially
 of every kind, saving her self and after her decease it is my will
 and desire that she the same remain to my special use and to my
 son Andrew but in such a manner as she shall see good
 for her self and all the same stock horses and she dole
 furniture and all the property whatsoever she dole
 after the death of her mother, & she dole to my
 daughter and appoint my trusty friend John
 executor of my will and Nancy her self as of that
 last will and testament to be my hand
