 person also all the same stock household and skeleton
 furniture and all the property whatsoever
 after the death of his mother, either shortly or
 constitute and appoint my trusty friend John
 executor of my will and Nancy first care of the
 last will and testament to be my hand

 the same land in fee simple.
 Then at my last will I give my daughter
 my love and bequeath to her the same
 at my decease at that time I give to
 my daughter, to wit Polly Long
 and my wife and bequeath to her
 to be equally divided amongst them
 Lastly I appoint my wife Elizabeth Long
 my executor and my son Moses and his
 to hold executing of this my will &
 testament in witness whereof I have
 set my hand and seal this 10 day of
 July in the year of our lord 1819
