and Mary Jane Todd as aforesaid - It is my will also that the
said property real personal & mixed shall remain in the care and
use of my late son George Todd and his heirs until my
Grand Daughter Anne B. Montague shall die - I shall in any manner to the
use of twenty one years at which time I leave this shall respectively
become their own property of the persons herein devised -
I will fully & lawfully give and pay unto my Grand Daughter
Anne Galey Montague the full benefit of the donation of the
aforesaid premises.

left her I do also give all power to my beloved wife to sell my lands or
Reverend debts due to me in Ireland as witness my hand seal this
Twenty Eighth day of August the thousand eight hundred and twenty
three
