The whole of the property herein devised and bequeathed to my daughter Elizabeth
Ward is expressly given to her for her own separate use and benefit, and
is not to be subject to the control or to any debts, contracts or liabilities of her
present or any future husband - For the purpose of securing to my said
daughter the entire use and benefit of the estate herein devised to her I hereby
appoint my friend Lysander Ford trustee for the management of the same

Lastly I hereby constitute and appoint Lysander Ford executor of this
my last will and testament hereby revoking all wills or testaments heretofore
