

I Lawrence Gordon of Franklin County do hereby make  
 my last will and testament in manner and form following  
 following that is to say 1<sup>st</sup> I desire that all of that possi-  
 ble part of my estate be immediately sold after my decease  
 except my real man and if my daughter Elizabeth Heyat  
 wishing I leave the same to her if she is not living the  
 man is to be sold and equally divided among my several  
 children after mentioned and after my said debts to be paid  
 out of the money arising from said Purchase property I  
 desire that it be equally divided between my several  
 except my son Lawrence Washington Gordon Godly after  
 the payment of my said debts and funeral expenses I  
 leave the plantation where I now live on containing one  
 hundred and fifteen acres and also my tract of land lying  
 on the Water of Sandy ruffe containing one hundred and  
 thirty three acres of land to my son Lawrence Washington  
 Gordon to him and his heirs by his paying the balance  
 of my children the after mentioned sum of money in three  
 yearly payments equal from my decease viz 1<sup>st</sup> to my  
 daughter Elizabeth Heyat seventy one Dollars and 42 Cts  
 to her and her heirs forever 2<sup>d</sup> to my Grand son William  
 Gordon seventy one Dollars and 42 Cts to him and his heirs  
 forever 3<sup>d</sup> to my son Mrs Gordon seventy one Dollars and 42 Cts  
 to him and his heirs forever 4<sup>th</sup> to my Daughter Lydia  
 Warfield seventy one Dollars 42 Cts 3<sup>rd</sup> to my son George  
 Gordon seventy one Dollars and 42 Cts 4<sup>th</sup> to my Daughter  
 Mary Harrod seventy one Dollars and 42 Cts to her and her  
 heirs forever 5<sup>th</sup> to my Daughter Maria Gordon seventy one  
 Dollars and 42 Cts to her and her heirs forever I desire that  
 the above named sums of money is to be paid by my son  
 Washington in current hand notes of Kentucky and when  
 my son Lawrence Washington Gordon shall pay the  
 above named sums of money to the above or upon  
 mentioned children them and their heirs after the after  
 mentioned levy of land I give to him and his heirs and  
 assigns forever and lastly I do hereby constitute and  
 appoint my son Lawrence Washington Gordon and Joseph  
 receipt executor of this my last will and testament  
 hereby revoking all other former wills or testaments by  
 me heretofore made in which I have been unto sitting  
 hand and affix my seal this the 27<sup>th</sup> day of one thousand  
 eight hundred and thirty nine  
 signed and sealed & declared in presence of  
 Lawrence Gordon  
 for the last will & testament

 I Ambrose White of the County of Franklin and state of Kentucky  
 do make this my last will and testament in manner & form following  
 that is to say - 1<sup>st</sup> I give to my Daughter Polly Church widow  
 of Thomas Church dec'd Ten Dollars - 2<sup>d</sup> I give to John Campbell  
 who intermarried with my Daughter Polly Church has since  
 departed this life Ten Dollars - 3<sup>d</sup> I give to James Boyant  
 Church the son of Henderson Church and Charlotte his wife both  
 of whom are now dead Ten Dollars 4<sup>th</sup> I give to my beloved  
 wife Cynthia, all the remainder of my Estate Real Personal &  
 mixed what I now possess or may be in possession of at the time  
 of my death - And lastly, I do hereby constitute and appoint  
 my wife Cynthia Church and John Morris and Gustavus  
 Wray Executors of this my last will and testament hereby revoking  
 all other former wills or Testaments by me heretofore made -  
 It is my wish and desire that no security be required of my  
 Executors or Executors - In Witness whereof I have hereunto set  
 my hand and affix my seal this twenty sixth day of January  
 in the year of Liberty one thousand eight hundred and thirty four  
 Signed, sealed and declared as the  
 last will and Testament of the above
