17. It is my will and desire that my executor buy out a profitable quantity all of the above slaves (except John Wales and Jane) and their increase until the periods respectively arrive at which they are to be free and I further authorize and empower my said executor to make any contract he may think proper with the said slaves at their increase for the purchase of them of the time that they or their increase may have to serve.
18. It is my will and desire that my executor vend out or sell as he may deem most expedient all my real Estate whereas the same may be and also any legal or equitable right that I may have in or to any lands or real Estate and I hereby vest him with full power and authority so to do.
19. It is further my will and desire that after the payment of my just debts and the foregoing legacies that all the proceeds of the real estate of my real Estate and the proceeds of the time or sale of the time of the said slaves and the proceeds of all debts due me and of all and every species of Estate real personal or mixed to which I may be entitled and all moneys or legacies into four equal parts.
20. It is my will and desire and I hereby bequeath my said last mentioned four equal parts to my grand daughter Mary Ann Sprule.
21. I hereby bequeath one fourth of said last mentioned four equal parts to my grand daughter Margarette B. Sprule.
22. I hereby bequeath the other third of said last mentioned four equal parts to my grand daughter Elizabeth Humphreys.
23. The remaining one fourth of the above last mentioned four equal parts I hereby bequeath to my executor David C. Humphreys in trust for her life and experience an of my daughter Elizabeth S. Todd during her life and after her death for her children that is to say the said Elizabeth is to receive during her life whatever interest may be received on said share the same to be paid to her annually and after her death the whole of the principal is to be paid over to her children and for the purpose of executing this trust to the best advantage I hereby authorize my said executor to leave out the hole or any part of said share that he may deem expedient or to vest the same in any part thereof stocks of any description and afterwards from time to time as he may deem expedient to sell the said stocks and receive or have the proceeds

as he may think most beneficial to the purposes of the trust.

24. I hereby nominate and appoint my son David C. 25. In the name of God Amen I William H. Price being full of mind and memory make this my last will and testament:

1st I give to my natural heirs at law all the property of which I am possessed without any special direction being satisfied with the provisions of the law upon that subject.

2nd I appoint my wife Elizabeth H. Price executrix and my father Isaac Todd executrix of my Estate and in case of death or unwillingness to serve upon that part of my father Isaac Todd present in his place my brother in law decedent's wife Elizabeth Todd and in case of failure on her part my brother John H. Price.

3rd I authorize my executors and hereby vest them with full power to receive part of my personal Estate as herein it may be deemed conducive to the interest of the heirs I also grant them the same power to purchase personal or real Estate for the benefit of the heirs, In witness whereof I set my hand and seal this 16th day of March 1836
