Prudence

In the name of Almighty God by whom I hope for the resurrection of the just at the last day Amen I Prudence Hensley of Frankfort Kentucky, being advanced in years and in feeble bodily health but of sound mind and disposing memory do hereby make, ordain and publish this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all other or former wills and especially revoking a will made by me a number of years ago, and which I now suppose is in the possession of my daughter Laura now in Canada in manner and form as follows to wit

- 1st I give to my son Edward Hensley my house & lot on Jones street in Frankfort, Kentucky,
 - 2nd I give to my daughter Elizabeth L. Woodbridge whatever lands may belong to her in the State of Ohio, if any lands in that State belongs to me as the heir at law of my son Jack Hensley deceased, 3rd I give to my daughter Maria H. Starling a lot of ground I own in Jeffersonville, Indiana
 - 4th I give to Maria H. Starling, Lanna Torrence, Elizabeth L. Woodbridge & Edward Hensley in equal proportions and value all the lots that I own in Dupreer city.
 - 5th I give to my daughter Lanna Torrence of Canada all the real estate which I own in New Orleans and which I received under the will of my son Dr. G. Hensley, this I do in accordance with a will against of my said son Dr. G. Hensley, but my said daughter Lanna shall not take this New Orleans property unless she lives longer than I do and she shall only have this New Orleans property and enjoy the same so long as she lives, and at her death my will shall be that at the death of my said daughter Lanna, the whole of said New Orleans property which I devised under the will of my said son Dr. G. Hensley shall be equally divided between all of my heirs at law but my said daughter Lanna over and above one thousand dollars on various accounts and she shall pay to my executor this \$1000. before she takes possession of the New Orleans property, 6th All other demands, claims and property of every kind belonging to me I hereby give to my son Edward Hensley after the payment of all my just debts & funeral expenses, including all my claims to lands in Texas.
- And lastly I hereby nominate & appoint my son Edward Hensley executor of this my last will and testament.
