property as directed in this will

2 I give unto my son Thomas Bradford one dollar in a dollar to what he has before
to be paid out of my estate I give to my son Alexander Bradford all that parcel of land
wherein he now lives commencing on the line of Tom Dillons and of 40 Acres corner the
North corner with a drain of my back line to that amount more or less
I also give to my son John Bradford one dollar in a dollar to what he has before
and I give to my wife another will that after she death my wife that all such
property both real and personal that I shall receive or be equally divided between
my children as follows to wit the heirs of John Bradford and the heirs of
Alexander Bradford and the heirs of John Bradford and the heirs of
Alexander Bradford the executor of this will

the same for and during the period of her natural life or widowhood out of which she is to
and I expect my infant children and educate them and at her death or if she shall
again then the whole to be equally divided among all my children living and the
which Sarah P. Newton has already received as her share for her share of her share
Thomas Hall Sarah Jane Hall Ann Maria Hall and Emma Hall

Item 3 I have already given to my daughter Sarah P. Newton a horse saddle
worth eighty dollars and a pair of shoes worth forty dollars and a bureau worth
fifty dollars and the other children are all to receive an amount equal to this and then an equal
division of the residue to be made among them all
Item 4 In case my wife should die or marry before my infant children become of age or marry
my will is desire that the property heretofore bequeathed them shall be held by my executor
for their education and support until they all become of age or marry

Item 5 Should any of my negroes become unruly and difficult to govern or else to select
executors or such as may be along with the consent of my wife are authorized to sell them
the proceeds thereof in all respects subject to the disposition of this will

Item 6 I do hereby appoint and request that my friend John P. Reading of
Franklin County Ky Esquire be my executor of this my last
will and testament
Item 7 I do hereby declare that the part of my estate which may
be coming to my daughter Sarah P. Newton under the foregoing provisions of this will shall
only belong to her during her life time and at her death to her heirs
