The condition of the above Obligation is such that if the said Hugh S. Galtwood & John Scott Bailiffs of the County of Archibald Campbell do make a true and perfect Inventory of all the goods Chattels rights & Credits of the said deceased which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said Hugh S. Galtwood & John Scott or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for them and the same so made do exhibit into the County Court of Galtwood when they shall be thereto required by the said Court and such goods Chattels and Credits do well and truly administer according to law and further do make a true and true account of their doings and dealings there in when thereto required by the said Court then all the rest of the said Goods Chattels & Credits which shall be
