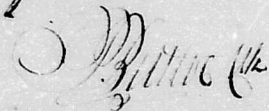

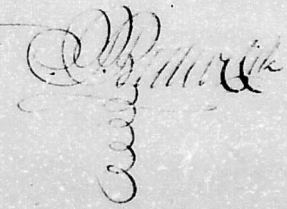

Know all men by these presents that we David Walter Joseph Jones and Shewood Walter are full and jointly bound to the said Justice of the Peace of Gallatin County, now sitting in Court

and their successors in sum of six hundred pounds to the payment of which, with and truly to be made to the said Justice and their successors to be and as to be and each of our heirs &c jointly and severally owing by these presents sealed and dated this 22^d day of September 1806.

The condition of this obligation is such, that if the said David Walter, Adminstrator of the goods Chattels and Credits of James Walter deceased, do make a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased, which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of the said David Walter, or in the hands or possession of any other person or persons for him, another, some or sundry do exhibit into the Court of Gallatin County when he shall be there required by the said Court, and such goods Chattels and Credits do sold and truly receive according to law; and further do make a just and true account of all his receipts and disbursements, when thereto required by the said Court, and do the rest of the said goods Chattels & Credits

which shall be found remaining upon the account
of the said Administrator, the same being first
examined and allowed by the Justices of the
said Court for the time being, shall deliver and
pay to such persons respectively as are entitled
to the same by law; and if it shall hereafter
appear that any false bill and account was
made by the deceased and the same be proved
in Court, and the Executor obtain a judgment
of the Court thereon, and the said David
Mottos do, in such case being required, make
and deliver up his letters of Administration
then this obligation to be void or else in full
force.
