

Know all Men by these presents that we Sarah Crawford
 of Gallatin County, Rich and Masterson & William Ellis
 are here and jointly bound unto John M. Rice, Magis-
 trate & David Brown Gent. Justices of the Court of
 Gallatin County, now sitting in Court, and their successors
 in the just and full sum of One thousand pounds,
 to the payment of which we do and truly to be made
 to be bind ourselves, our and each of our heirs, Execu-
 tors and Administrators jointly and severally firm
 by these presents Sealed with our seals and dated
 this 27th day of May 1805.

The condition of the above
 obligation is such, that if the above bound Sarah
 Crawford, Administratrix of the goods Chattels and
 credits of John Crawford deceased, do make a true
 and perfect Inventory of all and singular the
 goods Chattels and credits of the said deceased
 which have or shall come to the hands pos-
 session or knowledge of her the said Sarah Crawford,
 or into the hands or possession of any other person
 or person for her; And the same so made, exhibit
 into the Court of Gallatin County, when there is required
 by the said Court, and such goods Chattels and
 credits do well and truly administer, according
 to Law; And further do make a just and true

account of all her doings and doings therein.
 When thereunto required by the said Court. And all
 the rest of the said goods Chattels and credits which
 shall be found remaining in the said Administratrix
 in, the same being so much and allowed by the
 said Court Justices of the said Court for the time
 being, shall deliver and pay unto such person
 respectively, as are entitled to the same by Law;
 And if it shall hereafter appear that any false
 bill and Testament was made by the deceased,
 and the same be proved in Court, and the Executor
 obtain a Certificate of the probate thereof, and
 the said Sarah Crawford do in this case, being
 required under and deliver up her letters of admi-
 nistration, then this obligation to be void, or else
 to remain in full force. Sarah Crawford
