The Conditions of the above obligation is such
 that if the above bound *Nathaniel Sanders* as
 Guardian of *Samuel Sanders* orphan child of
John Sanders deceased, shall well and truly
 pay and oblige all Estate that now is, or
 which shall hereafter become due the said
 orphan when he shall attain the age
 ago to demand the same; and shall in
 all things faithfully execute and discharge
 the duties required of him by law, then the above
 obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in
 full force

 these presents sealed and dated this 9th day of December
 1811. The Condition of this obligation is that if the
 above bound *Jonathan Jennings* as Guardian of
Robert Edmonston, Infant orphan of *William*
Edmonston dec, his heirs Executors and administra-
 tors shall well and truly pay and oblige all such
 Estate as now is, or shall hereafter appear due the
 said orphan, when he shall attain to the age
 to demand the same, or when thereto required by the
 Justices of the said County for the time being,
 and in all things faithfully to execute the duties
 of his office according to law, then this obligation
 to be void, otherwise to remain in full force.
