 and seal in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and thirteen, and the 11th day of Janu-
 ary.

Know all men by these presents that Mary Vely and others being her husband and family bound unto the Commonwealth of Kentucky in the first and full sum of three hundred dollars to the payment of which will and duty to be made to the said Commonwealth we bind ourselves and our Executors and Administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents made and dated this 5th day of February 1813 - The Condition of the above obligation

is that if the said Mary Vely Administratrix with the annexed of the last will and Testament of said the goods Chattels and Credits of Samuel Vely dec. do make a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the goods Chattels and Credits of the said deceased which have or shall come to the hands possession or knowledge of her or the said Mary Vely or into the hands or possession of any other person or persons for her; And the same so made do exhibit into the Court of Gallatin County, at such time as she shall be thereto required by the said Court, and the same goods Chattels and Credits do sell and truly administer according to law, and here a just and true account of all her doings and things therein when thereto required by the said Court; And further, do well and truly pay and deliver all legacies contained and specified in the said will, as far as the said goods Chattels and Credits will extend according to the value thereof and as the law shall charge her, then this obligation to be void, or else to remain in full force
