Memory thanks be given to god. Calling unto mind the
mortality of my body and knowing that it is appo-
-inted once for all ^{over} me to die do make and
ordain this my last will and testament, the
is to say principally and first of all I give and re-
-surrender my soul into the hands of Almighty God
that first gave it, and my body I recommend
to the earth to be buried in decent and decent
Christian Burial at the Discretion of my Executors
Nothing doubting but at the resurrection I shall
receive the same again by the Mighty power of
God and as touching such worldly Estate which
- with it has pleased god to bless me ^{with} in this life
I give devise and dispose of the same in
the following manner and power

I first give to my sons Alexander John and Jeph
with my Daughters Mary Agnes James Alfred my
Grandson an equal part of the property I now possess
Manuel a Negro man by the name of Peter also
a Negro Woman Mary and child named Jimmy
with all my Household furniture which is to be
sold and an equal Division to be made to my above
named Children and grand child at my wife's decease
and I hereby utterly disallow revoke and disannul all
and every other Testament and Will bequeaths and
Bequests by me in any way before named wills
or bequeaths ratifying and confirming none other
to be my last Will and Testament In
Witness Whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this 22nd day of June 1798
