In the name of God Amen. I John
Stapp of Garrard County and State of Kentucky
do hereby constitute & Ordain this my last will
and Testament. In the first Place all
my Just Ditties and Funeral Expenses must be
paid. In the second Place I give & bequeath
all my real & Personal Estate of whatsoever
kind my wife Rachael Stapp & my Children
(to wit) Polly Stapp, John Stapp, Eliza Stapp,
William Stapp, Sally Stapp, Rachael Stapp
and I James Stapp to them and their
Heirs forever to be Equally divided between
them & their Respective Portions to be paid
& delivered over to each of them as they arrive to
the age of Seventyone or get Married, Except
my wife who is to be put in the Possession of
her share of the said real & Personal Estate
as soon after my death as my Executors herein
after named may be enabled to make an
Equal Division. In the third place it is to
my desire that my Executor shall have
the Direction of the Education of my Children
during their minority & that he shall have
Power to give them such Learning as he may
in his discretion may think fit with their
Situation & Capacities & of the profits arising
from their Respective portions hereafter to come

shall not be sufficient to pay the Expence of them
 Respecter Education, where a direction is to be made
 from this part of the Estate, In the fourth
 place as some time will Elope before my Executor
 will be able to make a Division of the Estate
 it is my desire that the plantation Wharves I now
 live shall be rented and the Rents here, but the
 Rents & profits arising therefrom to be Equally
 divided between my said Wife & Children
 Except what my Executor may think proper to
 Expence in support & Maintenance of them.

In the fifth place it is my desire that if any
 Claim should arise against my Estate upon
 any Contract which I have made or from any
 thing that I have done ^{in Contract} during my life time
 that my Executor shall have full power to compromise
 or settle any such Claim or Claims
 in any manner he may think best and may
 take any part of my Estate to satisfy any Claim
 that may be made good against my Estate

In the sixth place I do hereby ^{appoint} John Jones
 of Jamaica County the sole Executor of this my
 last will & Testament hereby revoking & annulling all
 others. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and affixed my seal this 4th day of December 1802
