

My Rachel Stapp Will

In the name of God Amen. I Rachel Stapp being in a weak state of health but of perfect mind and of sound memory and Calling to mind my worldly affairs make this my last Will and Testament; In the first place I resign my Body to the Ground to be buried in a Christian like manner, and my soul to God who gave it. Secondly my Eighth part of my Father's Estate, Real and personal, I wish to have Equally between my four Children to wit, William Stapp, my Son, Stapp Rachel Stapp and James Stapp. The last test Bees to be given to my Daughter Sally and Rachel but the price of said Bees to be taken out of the said Sally and Rachel's parts. Thirdly, my Negro Woman Sally and her Child to be the two girls and for their use until they attain to the age of twenty one years old or get married, fourthly I appoint the Jofy of Governor's Council of President to Execute & manage my affairs and wish no security. In witness whereof I have signed this 27 Day Decr 1804
