being in the best State of health but of Perfect
Mind and memory do make and ordain this my
last will and Testament (viz), after my just
Debts are paid - Item I give & bequeath to
my two sons John & Thomas two thirds of the
Land which I have both Richard Adams and
William Marshall Bond for. Given on the
Water of Rising to be Equally divided between
them and if the Land cannot be obtained
it is my desire that two thirds of the money
that is due from said Adams & Marshall for
said Land shall be Equally divided between
between my two sons John & Thomas Poor
together with the Lawful Interest. The above
Mentioned Land being twice surveyed and
Item I give & bequeath to my son John Poor one
Negro ^{man} named Roger to him and his heirs forever
Item I give and bequeath to my son Thomas Poor
one Negro man named Cupit to him & his
heirs forever Item I give & bequeath to my
Daughter Susannah one Negro Girl named
Rachel to her and her heirs forever - -
Item I give and bequeath to my son W^m Poor
and his heirs forever one Negro woman

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I shall which he is now in the Possession
Item I Give to my daughter Mary Pollock being
her life one Negro woman named Beck &
after her death since she has been in Possession
- in full of said Negro woman Beck & at the death
of my daughter Mary Pollock it is my desire
that the said Negro woman Beck & all her increase
be Equally divided amongst all my daughter
Pollock's children - Lawfully Begotten & born
Item I Give and bequeath to my daughter Hope
Branshaw and her heirs for ever one Negro boy
named Gill which is now in her Possession
Item I Give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth
Taylor one Negro woman named Mary
Ann Inman to her and her heirs forever
which is now in Possession - -
Item I Give & bequeath to my daughter Mary
Crawford one Negro woman named Jean & her
Increase to her and her heirs forever - which
is now in Possession - -
Item I Give and bequeath to my daughter Sally
Lewis one Negro Girl named Agge and her
Increase to her and her heirs forever -
which is now in her Possession
Item it is my will and desire that James
Crawford shall have the collection of the bond

Deed from Richard Adams and William
Marshall and when he collects the Bond
With the Interest there it is my desire that
the said Crowder shall receive Fifty Pounds
as a compensation for his trouble out of the
same & then to divide as before mentioned
Between my son John & Thomas Poor --

As to the residue of my Estate both Real &
Personal which have not before been mentioned
it is my will and desire that it shall be Equally
divided between such of my Children & others
herein after mentioned: to wit. John Poor
Thomas Poor Hope Bradshaw Elizabeth Taylor
Nancy Crowder Susannah Felice Sally Lewis
and my Grand son Robt. Poor son of William
Poor to them and their heirs forever.

Except the Land where I now live & it is my
will and desire that my sons John & Tho. Poor
shall have the Privilege of making Two Crops
on it after my Death. W^{ch} the Land can
be procured or the money collected with the
Interest from Adams & Marshall sooner
at which time or at the expiration of Two
years it is my desire that the Land shall
be Equally divided as before mentioned to wit,

Between John Poor Tho. Poor Hope
Bradshaw Elizabeth Taylor Nancy Crowder
Susannah Felice Sally Lewis & my Grand
son Robt. Poor son of William Poor
to them & their heirs forever & lastly.

I nominate & appoint my sons John Poor
& Tho. Poor & James Crowder Executors
of this my last will & Testament
In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand. This 20th Day of July 1801.
