County and State of Kentucky being in Body but Sained
in Memory blessed be god for his mercies. Do this
Twenty . day of May in the year of our lord
one thousand Seven hundred and Ninety six
Make this my last Will and Testament in
Manner following, I give unto my Son John Scott
of Fayette County and State of fine shillings likewise
I give unto my Son John Scotts Children which
his first wife had (viz) Samuel Scott Thomas
Brown Scott Sarah Scott Robert Scott and
William Scott. That plantation lying in York
County and State of Pennsylvania bounded by land
of William Read and Thomas Shannon to be
hold and the money to be Equally Divided amongst
of Children. like wise I order all the rest
of my Estate Real and personal in the

Money following my lands to be sold and if not sold to
be rented by my Executors, if sold the money arising from
said lands together with the money coming from
Thomas Patterson of York County and State of
Pennsylvania to be to be devoted in the following ma-
-ner, first I bequeath unto my son Joseph Scott fifty
Pounds Pennsylvania Currency to be paid unto
Joseph Scott out of the last money to be collected
of my Estate likewise I allow my son Joseph
Scotts Children one sixth part of my Estate together
with the above fifty Pounds to be equally divided
amongst them likewise I leave one sixth part of
my Estate Exclusive of the above fifty Pounds
to my son Roberts Scotts Children of York
County and State of Pennsylvania born to him
by Jane Scott Widow of William Scott Deceased
to be equally Divided amongst them. Likewise
I give to my son William Scotts Children one sixth
part of my Estate, Exclusive of the above fifty Pounds
to Joseph Scott, to be divided equally amongst them
likewise one sixth part, to my daughter Hannah
Brown Dec'ds Children to be equally divided amongst
them Exclusive of the above mentioned fifty pounds
to Joseph Scott —

likewise one sixth part Exclusive of the above fifty
pounds to Joseph Scott to be equally divided amongst
my daughter Mary Braigs Children and likewise
and likewise one sixth part to my daughter Jacob
Morley the Children to be equally Divided amongst
them Exclusive of the above mentioned fifty pounds
to Joseph Scott and that there may be no mis-
understanding about the fifty pounds mentioned
to Joseph Scott my meaning is that his Children
is to have ~~the whole~~ more than any of
my Childrens Children. Likewise I give all
my wearing apparel to my son William Scott
likewise I leave to my son Roberts Scott of
York County and State of Pennsylvania five
Shillings to my son Joseph Scott five Shillings
to my son William Scott five Shillings to
my Son-in-law W^m Brown five Shillings to
my Son-in-law Robert Crag five Shillings to
my Son-in-law turning Morley five Shillings
and as some of my sons and Son-in-laws has got
more than others of them so I leave a Book
account to show who has got more and who
has got less and who ever has got more than
others is to have less now that they may
be made equal. The money arising from
