healthy and thriving and satisfied I have been in
Newport Garrison about seven months well now the
Order has come that our Captain Perry Caplan has
to go down to Vincennes some time I suppose about
thousand forty mile and there they tell me of but one
man in the Garrison and I hope that I will return
from the United States Army or being there as of battle
I hope that I going to long home or have laid
to bed upon I thought it the great wonder that I
should return from United States Army I am how-
glad I am and how much I prize I would make
for I be glad to see all my friend now when this
letter to you let my sister Miss Maryon hear it
now the company it come from Lancaster there
is from men devoted out of our that come from
Lancaster now Thomas Davis the other John
Henderson in one night devoted in March in a few
day after that there is Benjamin Lacey and David
Baker devoted one night in the same month now
this letter I have written by June the 3rd first sun-
day and next Sunday I have heard some one
all start down the river and now I have seen
letter that John Ramsay has send to me that the
letter say I must try to send a letter to kindred where
share be my feather bed for I understand that

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he gone to Maine near fault to Duck River
and now Mr. Larkin Ramsay I will be
very much obligate to you if you could take in my
feather bed tick and two old sheet and two blanket
it and one iron bed and keep it till I ever
return return from the army and if I never re-
turn from army my Will is to go to my sister
for Miss Maryon the feather bed and bed
cloth I remember old David Ramsay I re-
member old Grand Ramsay I remember John
Ramsay I remember Thomas Ramsay I remember Pe-
rry Ramsay I remember all your friends

heirs forever And I Give and bequeath to my
sister Sally Gibson in Fauquier County Virginia
one Negro Woman known by the name of
Minnie to her and her heirs forever

And I Give and bequeath to my sister Ruthy
one Negro Girl known by the name of Rachel
to her and her heirs forever also my Will and
Desire is that the above given Negroes shall not
be removed out of the state of Kentucky.

And I Give and bequeath to my Aunt Peggy
Ashins and her children my Cart three horses
riding carriage and one bed and furniture
with all the household furniture belonging to
me in this state to be divided as followeth that is
after my Aunt Peggy Ashins and John Ashins
her son have fifty Dollars each them to have an
equal share with thers that is after my legal
Dolls is paid and I do hereby make and beain
John Ashins my Executor to execute this my last
will.
