worldly estate it hath pleased God to bestow
me with I give after my just debts are paid
in manner and form following that is to say
I give unto my loving Mother twenty
pounds current money and one Grey mare
I give unto my sister Nancy Pemberton
three pounds current money I give unto my
brother John Leavelle all my wearing clothes
I give unto my brother John Leavelle's chil-
dren and Edward Leavelle all the money
that is due me after the Legacies that is before
mentioned are paid excepting the hire of my Negroes
this be it that I gave that I gave unto my
Brother William Leavelle I give unto my
(Brother)

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brother William Leavelle the hire of my two Negroes
Cato and Lot from this date during his natural life
and I constitute and appoint my friend William
Pemberton to be a trusty friend in hiring the
said Negroes as my own Executors and the mon-
ey to be paid by him to my Brother William Leavelle
during his natural life to this my last Will and
Testament hereafter reciting and discharging &
making void all other Wills by me hereafter made
In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and affixed my seal this seventeenth day of
October and thousand seven hundred and seven-
ty five
