I do hereby confirm said gift I also further
Will that my wife's marriage or as case that
negroes under be free all the rest of my estate
that may then be in hand, and not in this
Will given away, be sold equally divided
among my seven children viz John Marksherry
Samuel Marksherry's heirs Rachel
Banks's heirs Isaac Marksherry, Nancy
Fugate, Milly Baker and Delilah Hogan
Lastly I do appoint my three sons John
Marksherry, Isaac Marksherry, and

William Marksherry Executors of the my last
Will & Testament in testimony whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and affixed my
seal this 25th Day of December in the year
of our Lord 1813.

forever after paying one hundred pounds
to my heirs to be equally divided among
Robert Jacks, John and George then that has
had the most to pay back to them that has
had the least and my heirs to have a square
Share with the four boys in here mentioned
Sarah, Margaret, & Jane the money arising from
the sale of my estate one hundred pounds each
It is my Will and desire that George is to have
my Mill works to be valued to him and if it
comes to more than his share he must pay to
them that have so much and lastly I do
appoint my son Robert & Jacks Robinson my
executors to this my last Will and Testament
