be coming to the first of the children after
my wife Rhoda Nelsons decease by the
profits of my estate to be equally divided
between the eight children mentioned
always provided that my wife shall
not be answerable for any reasonable
expensetions during her widowhood —
I appoint my beloved wife Rhoda
Nelson my executrix my son Daniel
Nelson Joshua Blanton junior
Vincent & those my Executors to this
my last will utterly revoking &
disannulling

all other wills by me before made confirmed
— into be my last I testimony whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and
affixed my seal in 1797 the Day and Day
of the month before mentioned
