no land then what remains to be equally divided
among ^{all} my children that is to say Purnett,
Martha, Barreba, Jacob, Stephen, William, Tabby,
Eli, and Esther and my whole executrix is my
wife Keriah Bloid. In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my seal this 30th day of March
in the year of Christ 1809

good will I bear and bare to my loving wife do give

and grant unto her the said Susanah wife of me Charles
Sidebottom all my hole estate during her life or natural
life or widowhood consisting of Lands houses cattle hogs sheep
geese ducks & together with all my household goods and
kitchen furniture to her and the ruin of her body forever
at her death or marriage as follows to wit, that her sons
shall have all my land and houses equally divided between
them. Also her daughters shall have all and every other
part of my estate namely cattle, hogs, sheep, geese
ducks & together household goods and kitchen furniture
at my death and I do further promise I will not sell
and or give any part of the above mentioned estate to my
children born of my former wife, except five shillings
apiece. This I acknowledge is my will and pleasure
and bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to
fulfill and abide by the true intent of the same whereunto
I have set my name and fix^d seal this eleventh
day of February 1806 Signed Sealed and delivered in presence
