Boy by the name of Daniel, a Negroe woman by
the name of Judith with all of her increase begining
at David, Molly, Franky, Wilson, Ann, Belia, Fanny
also a Negroe woman by the name of Edith, the aforesaid

Negroes I give unto my loving wife Martha Williams to
have and to hold forever to be at her disposal at her death
Item, I give and bequeath unto my ^{Loving} wife Martha Williams
four head of Horses namely Charlotte, Schuck Ool, Top Gallant,
and Hammer and Tong, the aforesaid Horses I give unto my
loving wife Martha Williams to have and to hold forever.
Item, I give and bequeath unto my loving wife Martha
Williams all my house hold and Kitchen furniture, to have
and to hold forever, two good fether beds and furniture
excepted. — Item, I also give and bequeath unto my
Loving wife Martha Williams one third part of all my
plantation working tools, also one third part of all the
crop that will be made the present year to dispose of
as she may think proper, Item, I give and bequeath
unto my loving wife Martha Williams the tract of Land
I now live on containing about four hundred and forty
four acres, to have and to hold during her natural life
at her death it is my will and desire that said land
should be returned unto my loving Children. Item, I also
give and bequeath unto my loving wife Martha
Williams one third part of all my stock of Cattle and
hogs, and it is further my will and desire that she
should have all my stock of sheep, Item, I give and
bequeath unto my loving Children, Jane Watson and
Athene Scott all the rest and residue of my estate
except Lands that has not been already devised, &c.

further my will and desire that all my lands but the tract Snowline on should be sold at the discretion of my Executor and Executrix and the monies arising therefrom to be applied to the payment of my Just debts.

It is further my will and desire that all monies due my estate should be collected and applied towards the necessary charges that may arise, and the residue to the payments of my Just debts. — It is further my will and desire that if the residue of the monies above mentioned and the monies arising from the sale of said Lands should not be sufficient to pay all my Just debts then it is my will and desire that my loving wife Martha Williams shall pay one third part of the residue of my Just debts, as well as one third part of any debt that may be recovered against my estate. —

Lastly and all the residue of my Estate of what nature or kind soever it may be not herein before particularly disposed of I desire may be equally divided between my

two Loving daughters herein before named whenever Jane Watson becomes of Age or Marries, which I give to them their heirs and assigns forever. And lastly I do

hereby constitute and appoint my loving wife Martha Williams Munford my Executrix, and my loving brother William Munford as my Executor of this my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I have
