and do acknowledge this to be my last. In witness, all the property ^{which} I have heretofore given to my married children viz, Thornton Buckner, Cate Taylor wife of John Taylor Louisa Buckner wife of Horace Buckner and Richard A Buckner, I confirm to them and their heirs forever; Item I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Buckner the following property to her and her heirs forever, one Negro woman named Molly, and her children Lucinda, Mariah, Adeline, and Spencer, one bed and furniture, one Cow and calf, Item I give to my son John Buckner the following property to him and his heirs forever; one Negro Man Abraham one D^o Jacob, Lucy, Phillis, Nancy, Matilda, and Alexander, also the tract of Land now live on and as part of the purchase money is still due, I desire that the balance of a Bond still due me from James H Rice given to my son Richard A. Buckner be applied to the payment of the Land, also one Bed and furniture with all my stock of every kind, but the Cow & Calf before given, and all my household and kitchen furniture with my gun and Pistols, Item I give to my son Richard A. Buckner all my right title and Interest that I have to a Tract of Land lying in Fauquier County Virginia on the watery Mountain adjoining the land I formerly gave to him and his heirs forever. Item it is also my will and desire that all my last debts should be paid out of the property which I have given to my son John Buckner — Also by these presents I convey to my son in law John Y. Taylor
