In the Name of God Amen I Lewis Chastain of County of Frederick & State of Virginia, being in Health of Body & sound of mind do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament
 Item I give and bequath to my Dear Son John Lewis Chastain at my Death all my wearing apparel my Riding Horse Saddle and Bridle and my watch
 Item I give and bequath to my Dear Daughter Nancy Bruce Chastain all my late wife's wearing apparel and her Saddle and a Bridle and Horse when she comes to the age of Eighteen or Maries, Item I give and Bequath to both my children a Bible & Hymn Book to be given them as soon as they learn to read, with this Injunction to read them through once a year during life
 Item I give and bequath unto my two Children Nancy Bruce Chastain and John Lewis Chastain all the Lands I may die possed of Equally to be divided between them or for the Land to be appraised by Competent Judges and John Lewis to pay his Sister Nancy Bruce one Half of said Appraisement. Item It is my Will and desire that the Negroes I may die possed of shall be free when they come to the ages I have specified the males till they are 25 years of age the females till they are 21 years of age and then to be Emancipated either by fully adm^r or my children who ever shall have the management of my Estate, It my Will and desire that all the Negroes I may die possed of that is as old as above specified shall be free at my Death, Item all my other property to be paid and all my Lawfull Debts paid the Balance to be equally divided between my two children I wish my dear Bro George Reed, my Dear Bro Stephen Chastain to administer on my Estate & be Guardians for my Dear children
