 Principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul into the hands of god who gave it and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of god But as touching worldly affairs which has pleased god to bless me in this life I give and dispose of in the following manner and form Viz, Principally and all together I give and bequeath to Martha my dear beloved wife the whole of my estate by her to be fully and freely to be enjoyed and to be disposed of at her pleasure Satisfaction and benefit of her son all children likewise the land which is now occupied by me in this life I give and bequeath to her all my right title and claim by her to be enjoyed and disposed of for the benefit of the same who I do institute and appoint the Sole Executrix of this my last will and Testament Ratifying and Confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament
