Executors hereafter named, And thirdly my
last debts to be paid, now as to what tem-
poral estate which God in his mercy has bestowed
on me I give (and bequeath as follows, I give
(and bequeath to my beloved wife Jane Nevitt all
my Estate both real & personal Consisting of my
tract of land whereon I now live, also my
Negro Ben together with my Household
(and Kitchen furniture farming utensils (and my
Stock of all kinds Consisting of Horses Hogs
Cows & Sheep except the legacies hereafter named
during her widow hood but should she marry
It is my Will (and desire she should have no
more than a Childs part, I do give (and
bequeath to my six Children Viz, Ann
John Chrysostrus Joseph Ambrose Thomas
David Charles Poromea and Mary Nevitt
a Horse & saddle to be Valued to sixty Dollars
when they arrive at the age of eighteen
years a shall marry and likewise to
have reasonable education each of them

It is also my Will (and desire that at the death
or Marriage of my wife the whole of my
Estate to divided Between my six aforemen-
tioned Children equally, It is also my Will
(and desire that my wife should have my
deadened hand cleared by giving a lease
on it And lastly I constitute (and appoint
my loving wife Jane executrix of this my
last Will & Testament, In Testimony whereof
I have hereunto set my hand (and seal this 26th
of March 1844
