 hundred acre tract by paying to my Daughter
 Elizabeth fifty Dollars out of the same Item I give
 & bequeath unto my son Michael Roof the tract of
 land he now lives on containing two hundred &
 fifty acres more or less to him and his heirs forever
 Item I give & bequeath unto my son in Law William
 Bazant ^{the plantation} on which he now lives containing one
 hundred acres by his paying to my Daughter
 Rosanna fifty Dollars to him his heirs for ever
 Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Susanna

Sunder the tract whereon she formerly lived containing one hundred acres by paying fifty Dollars out of the same in good trade to my Daughter Sally Roof to her & her heirs & Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Barbara Roof fifty acres of land adjoining the land of Catherine Whitstone to her & her heirs forever Item I give and bequeath to my two youngest Daughters Nancy & Rebeckah one hundred acres of land to be equally divided between them adjoining the land of William Bagart & Susanna Sunder to them and their heirs forever Item I give and bequeath unto my youngest son Nicholas Roof the plantation on which I live containing one hundred and forty acres also two other tracts the one containing fifty acres & the other ten acres which I purchased of Shepherd Gum & John Jeremiah likewise the Balance of all my land not willd away together with all my stock of Horses cows Dogs & sheep farming utensils of every description House hold and kitchen Furniture to him his heirs forever I do also constitute and appoint my beloved wife Barbary Roof Executrix & my son Nicholas Roof Executor of this my last will & Testament, & Witnes whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 21st day of April in the year of our Lord 1814
