 & Testament, in manner and form
 following to wit. First of all I order that
 all my Just debts and funeral charges
 be paid. Item I give and bequeath unto
 my beloved wife Rachel Hunter, all
 my estate, real & personal, during her
 State of Widow hood, and if she remaining
 a Widow till her decease, then the es-
 tate, real and personal shall be equal-
 ly divided among my children, each
 one an equal part, except only that my
 Wheelright Tools, with the Timber, and
 all belonging to that branch of business
 shall be sold to the best advantage
 and the money and profits arising there-
 from shall be put into the possession
 of my Executors, for the only use and
 benefit of my son Thomas Hunter, when
 he be comes of the age of Twenty one year
 But if my wife Rachel Hunter should
 marry, then she shall possess one third

part of my Estate, Real & personal except the above
 named Wheelwright Tools &c, and the remainder
 to be equally divided among my four children to wit,
 Eliza, Polly, Thomas, and Rebecca, And if
 my wife Rachel Hunter shall bear a son or a
 Daughter, with which she is at this time pregnant,
 It is my Will and desire that the same shall
 have an equal share with the other four of my
 children. I do also nominate, constitute and
 appoint my beloved wife Rachel Hunter Executor
 and Thomas Miller Executor of this my last Will
 and Testament, In Testimony whereof I
 hereunto set my hand and seal this Thirtieth
 day of January in the year of our Lord one
 thousand Eight hundred and Sixteen
